Definitions

Cargo

means articles of any kind whatsoever, transported or to be transported in a Container.

Container

means any standard ISO 20', 40' or 45' in length, 8' width and 8'6/9'6 in height including e.g. flat racks, platforms, reefers and tanks with ISO recommended lifting arrangements and consistent with the safety requirements of CSC (Convention for Safe Containers) plates, and which can be handled by means of a spreader.

Container Terminal

means the land and premises used by AGCT in or around the Port

Hazardous Cargo

means articles of any kind classified by the International Maritime Organisation, (IMO), as hazardous for man and/or the environment.

Inspection

means the activity requested by any authority such as Customs, Police, Phytosanitary, Veterinary, etc., and it can be any or all of the following but not limited to :

- a) Normal inspection
- b) Detailed inspection
- c) X Ray inspection

Non-standard Containers and Uncontainerized Cargo

means Containers or Cargo accepted for transport/carriage on a Container ship which cannot be handled by means of normal use of container spreader, even with special attachments.

Out of Gauge Cargo (OOG)

means a Container which must be handled with the use of special attachments to the spreader.

Rates/Tariff

means the prices charged by AGCT in respect of services rendered.

Storage

means the deposit of a container or cargo in the premises of the container terminal and will be counted as from the day of reception of said cargo or container by the terminal.

Stuffing

Means the partial or total loading of cargo into a container

Unstuffing

Means the partial or total unloading of cargo from a container
